As the Center for Alcohol Policy (The Center) desires a wide range of participants at its continuing legal education events, the Center is open to working with interested parties on financial assistance.

The Center offers discounted rates to registrants who come from a non-profit or government background to encourage the attendance of attorneys that work with community coalitions and education or public health groups that advocate for particular alcohol control policies. Additionally, the Center offers further discounted rates to all interested parties when an attendee registers before August 19, 2019.

If an individual desires to attend but cannot, even with both of the discounted rates, they are free to contact the Center via e-mail with a formal letter explaining their desired rate and what they do professionally in the alcohol law field. It is of utmost importance to the Center that there be a wide range of voices at our Alcohol Law and Policy Conferences, and as such, we are ready to work with all interested parties on financial assistance. Parties that are able to prove financial hardship and are unable to afford a discounted rate will be allowed to attend free of charge.
